Fall application deadline is February 1 with all application materials submitted to the Office of the Dean/Director. Spring application deadline is September 1 with all application materials submitted to the Office of the Dean/Director.

The Abilene Christian University School of Nursing will evaluate all complete applications that meet application requirements and rank them according to the BSN Prelicensure Ranking Point System. All requirements for application to the ACU SON must be met before the points system is considered for an applicant. The points system does not replace admission requirements. Since the number of applications usually exceeds the number of students accepted for admission, all applicants will be awarded points for ranking purposes. Applicants will be accepted into the program as ranked for admission, and according to the number of positions available. In instances where there are applicants with a tie according to total point scores, the applicant with the higher GPA of the Supplement for the Major will receive the higher ranking position.
