

I've made Thanksgiving dinner both in my mom's kitchen and also entirely in a toaster oven found in the corner of a Hell's Kitchen studio apartment. Some years, I loved my vagabond life, yet others, I longed for my small family, gathered around the table, where we'd enjoy our most cherished recipes. Each one leaves a snapshot in my heart. It's only one day out of the year, but I can remember almost every one of them. I think about the friends and loved ones who used to fill the seats around my table, and the many tiny feet that do now. I'm thankful for it all.

Moments matter. This moment matters - in a small Abilene black box on a Thursday night in November. It may only last for one night, but it matters. So enjoy this one night - with the people God has placed before you, IN the moment He has given you, in the place that He has you right now.


So here we are...thank you ACU and thank you dancers for welcoming me into this moment - on this night, with these people, in this place. Even if it's for "One Night Only"...
