Thank you for your interest in our Master of Accountancy (MAcc) program. The MAcc is a 30-hour program designed to be completed in one year for those who enter the program with an undergraduate degree in accounting. The MAcc is geared toward a career in public or private accounting, and is designed to satisfy the requirements of the Texas State Board of Public Accountancy to sit for the CPA exam. The MAcc is offered through the ACU College of Business Administration, which is AACSB-accredited, the highest accreditation available to recognize quality schools of business. Graduates of the program make significant contributions to the profession and society, exemplified by their leadership roles in accounting firms, corporate boardrooms, business startups, and not-for-profit organizations.

As a graduate student in the MAcc program, you will engage with faculty members and a cohort of fellow students that will challenge you to grow professionally, socially, and spiritually. Professionally, most of our MAcc graduates plan to begin their careers in public accounting, and many have participated in an accounting internship at some point during their academic career. You will be taught by faculty members who have 'real world' experience to bring into the classroom, in addition to their academic achievements. The competencies you gain by taking on the challenge of the MAcc program will prepare you for the CPA exam, and position you to explore a variety of career opportunities. Our career-placement rate for new graduates is typically at 100%.

Due to small class sizes, students are encouraged to interact with one another both in and out of the classroom. Friendships are developed that may follow you into your career, and can last a lifetime. As an ACU graduate, you become part of an alumni network that has been growing since 1906, creating new friendships and connections throughout the business world.

Most importantly, our prayer is that your time at ACU will provide an opportunity for you to establish a foundation of faith that will sustain you through the opportunities and challenges that life has to offer. Our faculty are actively involved in living out their faith through their church and other community-based organizations, and are intentional about mentoring and encouraging students to grow in Christ.
