

Director's Notes

In 2019, one of my students, Emily Wooten (now graduated), secured an internship with the La Jolla Playhouse in San Diego. The La Jolla Playhouse has the prestigious reputation of developing new works that have transferred to Broadway including Jersey Boys, Come From Away, Big River, I Am My Own Wife (also a Pulitzer Prize winner), The Who's Tommy and more. Emily contacted me saying "We just had our first read through and table work, and I can honestly say this is one of the best scripts I've ever seen...I think you would love it." Later on, I was able to secure a script, and Emily was right! I loved The Coast Starlight. Since the play wasn't published, I had to go through the playwright, Keith Bunin's, agent to obtain the rights to produce the show. After about three months, the agent and the playwright signed off on allowing the ACU Theatre permission to produce the play. Late last month, Playbill.com announced auditions were being held for the Broadway production of The Coast Starlight.

Lincoln Center is slated to produce the play in March 2023. It's pretty exciting to get to share a play with our audiences before it appears on Broadway.

I'm really looking forward to seeing it in New York!

The play is very different that any I have directed before. The device Bunin uses in the play is to explore the "what if's" and the "road not taken" with six strangers who are riding the train together. He exploits the tendency we all have when riding on an airplane, a train or other public transportation to wonder about the people sitting beside us or across the aisle from us. We sometimes make up imaginary stories and even have questions we want to ask. Rarely do we do act on this, but this is exactly what happens in *The Coast Starlight*. Bunin takes those imagined conversations and creates a smart, funny and compassionate story about our need for community. The play examines how each of us yearn for connection. We all have problems to resolve and, whether we realize it or not, we need to reach out to others for help.

I am so grateful for this wonderful cast and group of stage managers I have gotten to work with. We have had a joyous and meaningful trip on *The Coast Starlight*. I hope you experience a bit of that joy and are somewhat changed because of the play.

Playwright's Biography


KEITH BUNIN is currently writing screenplays for Universal Pictures, Paramount Pictures, CBS Films, Fox Animation, and Likely Story/Mandalay Films, among others. He wrote the screenplay for the film Horns, directed by Alexandre Aja, starring Daniel Radcliffe, and based on the novel by Joe Hill, which will be released later this year. He is the author of the plays The Busy World is Hushed, The World Over and The Credeaux Canvas, which were all originally produced Off-Broadway by Playwrights Horizons. His other plays include Sam Bendrix at the Bon Soir, produced by La Jolla Playhouse and City Theatre, Vera Laughed, produced by New York Stage and Film, The Principality of Sorrows, produced by Pure Orange Productions, The King of Clocks, produced by Lincoln Center Lab at HERE, and A Joke, produced by Malaparte. He wrote the book for the musical 10 Million Miles, which was produced Off-Broadway by the Atlantic Theatre Company. He was also a writer for the HBO TV-series "In Treatment." His essays have been published in American Film Magazine and on the web at McSweeney's. He received his B.A. from Goddard College and his M.A. from Columbia University.
