

January 2022 Review (2021 data)

The Program defines *Student Achievement* as: 1) 70% of students in each cohort will graduate in the advertised length of time; 2) 100% of students will maintain membership in the AAMFT during the entire length of the program; and, 3) 70% of students will earn minimum scores of 3 on the Capstone Paper and Presentation.

Graduation Rate *data for COAMFTE is a percentage of those who have *entered* the program

- 2015 - 17%
- 2016 - 11%
- 2017 -15%
- 2018 - 37%
- 2019 - 17%
- 2020 - 3%

**In version 12.5 of the COAMFTE standards, student achievement is not formally defined. Standard I refers to *student achievement* as "learning and the development of specific competencies measured against program goals."

The Program defines *Graduate Achievement* as: 1) 70% overall program graduation rate among those who begin the Foundational Practice Component; 2) a 70% pass rate among respondents on the AMFTRB National Exam; 3) a minimum of 70% of respondents will be working as marriage and family therapists; and 4) a minimum of 70% of respondents will be licensed in their state or province as MFTs

Graduation Rate (after beginning FPC)

- 224 students have begun MFTO 602
- 79 continue to matriculate
- 224-79 = 145
- 123 students have graduated/145 = 84%

Pass rate for respondents on the AMFTRB Exam

70% of respondents to the 2021 Annual Graduate Achievement Survey passed the exam.

*The data is higher on the website (94% average for last 5 years) since I am using reports from SF about exam pass rates.

Working as MFTs

61% of respondents to the Annual Graduate Achievement Survey are employed as an MFT.

Licensed as MFT

76% of respondents to the Annual Graduate Achievement Survey are licensed or provisionally licensed.
